Bracket Information: The tournament will be played as four 4-team brackets without elimination. Brackets will be seeded based on the results of group play. Brackets will be posted and updated on the APS Athletic Department website.

Event Information:

All tournament games will be posted on the APS Athletic Department website. Home teams are determined by the APS Athletic Department; for bracket play, the team listed on the top of the bracket is the home team.

The home team will keep the official score-book, wear dark jerseys/socks, provide game balls and will occupy the home team bench.

Placement in brackets will be determined by group play results. The following tie breaking procedures will be applied:

1. Head to head competition
2. Goal differential among tied teams (maximum of five goals per game)
3. Goal differential among entire group
4. Fewest goals allowed in all group games
5. Most goals scored in all group games (maximum of five goals per game)
6. Coin toss

Any time throughout tie-breaking procedures, when a multiple (3 or more) team tie is reduced to two teams, head-to-head competition will be used to determine higher placement.

Ties in pool play games at the end of regulation will result in a draw for both teams.

Ties in bracket play at the end of regulation will result in two 10 minute sudden-victory overtime periods. If still tied at the end of the two extra periods, the game will be settled by kicks from the mark (shootout), for advancement purposes only.

Results:

The event director will coordinate host site responsibilities with appropriate event personnel.

Awards:

Immediately following each game, game results will be confirmed with the center referee.

The championship trophy will be presented at the conclusion of each Gold Bracket Championship game.
