Re: Principal/ Assistant Principal Compensation Agreement 23-24

Superintendent Scott Elder, the Albuquerque Public Schools, and the Albuquerque Public Schools Principals Association (APSPA) agree on the following for 2023-24.

- Principals and Assistant Principals will receive a 6% salary increase based on their current salaries. The 6% increase will be added to each salary band.
- Elementary Principal salaries will be increased to the same amount as High School Assistant Principals. Their contract days (211) will remain the same.
- Principals and Assistant Principals at TOPS schools will be paid on the Middle School Salary Schedule.
- A taskforce of District Staff, Principals and Assistant Principals (selected collaboratively) will convene in January 2024 to study and make recommendations on the establishment of Principal and Assistant Principals stipends/differentials. (school size, #of District Special Education Programs, # of after hour's activities; credentials)
- Five Discretionary Days are included in Principal and Assistant Principal yearly calendar. Principals and Assistant Principals must get prior approval from their Associate Superintendent/Supervisor to use these days.
- Principals and Assistant Principals will continue to have one sick day converted to a personal day unless they have reached the personal day cap of 5 days.
- Conditions of employment are outlined in the Principal and Assistant Principal contract as well as the APS Employee Handbook. The Handbook can be found on the HR website.
